



The oldest person in Märjamaa parish is 101 years old



Social field

Subsistence benefit

Person is eligible for the benefit when after paying the utilities applicant remains with:

•1 person in family 76,7 euro

•2 people in family 138,06 euro

•3 people in family 199,42 euro

•4 people in family 260,78 euro

•5 people in family 322,14 euro

Each subsequent member of the family will receive 80% of the subsistence (61,36 eurot).

Legal guardianship

- In Märjamaa parish there are 27 adults under guardianship.
- In Märjamaa parish there are 10 foster families for minors and 12 children under guardianship.
- 4 kids are living in children's home.
- There are 4 alternate families and 4 children growing in them.
