

Why Innovative?

 Long process that started around 2010 (CSOs) and lasted until 2015.

 Building the political consensus: Was it worth asking for a successor to the MDGs? When to start?

- Finding the right space for the intergovernmental discussion: connecting the dimensions of [sustainable] development.
- From an agenda of halves to and agenda of universal access: increased ambition
- Promoting an universal agenda



The intergovernmental process:


- Open Working Group on the SDGs

Number of SDGs: focus on communication on what needs to be done?

Connecting the 'dots' at the United Nations: Poverty and Sustainable Development Agenda – Rio+20 + MDGs



Why Inclusive?

- Several opportunities of participation: including in the official intergovernmental negotiations.
- Interest and investment by civil society and nongovernmental actors: strategic to 'be' in the global agenda.
- Push for transparency: negotiations under scrutiny.

- A crowded field: joining civil society 'silos' (development and environment). Pressure on the system for more inclusion.
- If we weren't there? Ambition would be lower, several goals wouldn't be there
- Participation as part of the global commitment
- Ownership

Is Inclusion and Innovation Enough?

- Implementation is the real challenge Readapting sustainable development to the principles and commitments of the 2030 Agenda
- Universality as critical: Not an agenda for developing countries. A challenge for international partners to look and engage internally.

Accountability and participation: Advocacy, Watchdogs and

Implementers.
