- European Semester and Europe 2020 dominated and undermined by narrow economic focus.
- Lack of debate and little quality engagement on Europe 2020 and Semester

- Balanced approach
  - •impact assessment of all relevant policies including economic policies
  - Balanced CSRs
- Quality debate and engagement
- Sub-targets for specific marginalised groups and Gender Mainstreaming
- Poverty and Social Exclusion
  - Need an integrated strategy coordinated from EU level with national implementation. – not limited to labour market participation
- Employment
  - •An inclusive labour market with quality jobs
  - Active Inclusion approach for those most distant
- Education
  - •Include an adult literacy target.
- Climate Change
  - Greater ambition at EU and national level and need specific CSR for Ireland
