Preliminary descriptions

Workshop 1: "Follow-up to the Youth Initiative"	<i>Potential Focus : learning mobility, combatting youth unemployment, promoting participation and solidarity</i>
Workshop 2: "From Children to Young Adults: investing on the path out of poverty and towards a balanced life"	<i>Potential Focus: children, in particular those experiencing poverty, and how EU policies can (i) help them overcome initially disadvantageous situations and (ii) develop their full potential</i>
Workshop 3: "Intergenerational equity and combating youth poverty"	<i>Potential Focus: how social protection systems and labour related policies need to better reflect the fact that younger generations have greater challenges than in the past to fully integrate into employment and society.</i>
Workshop 4: "Addressing social inclusion challenges of young people in urban areas"	<i>Potential Focus: urban marginalisation of young people, situation of Roma people or, generally, youth belonging to an ethnic minority, young people with migrant background, etc.</i>
Workshop 5: "Addressing social inclusion challenges of young disabled people in urban areas"	<i>Potential Focus: social inclusion of young people with disabilities and de-institutionalisation.</i>
